

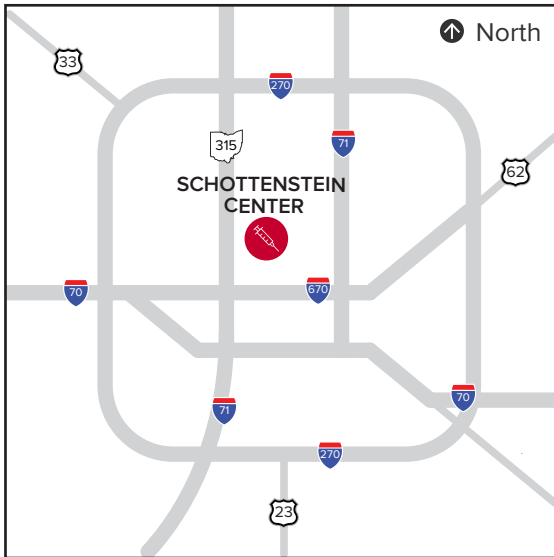

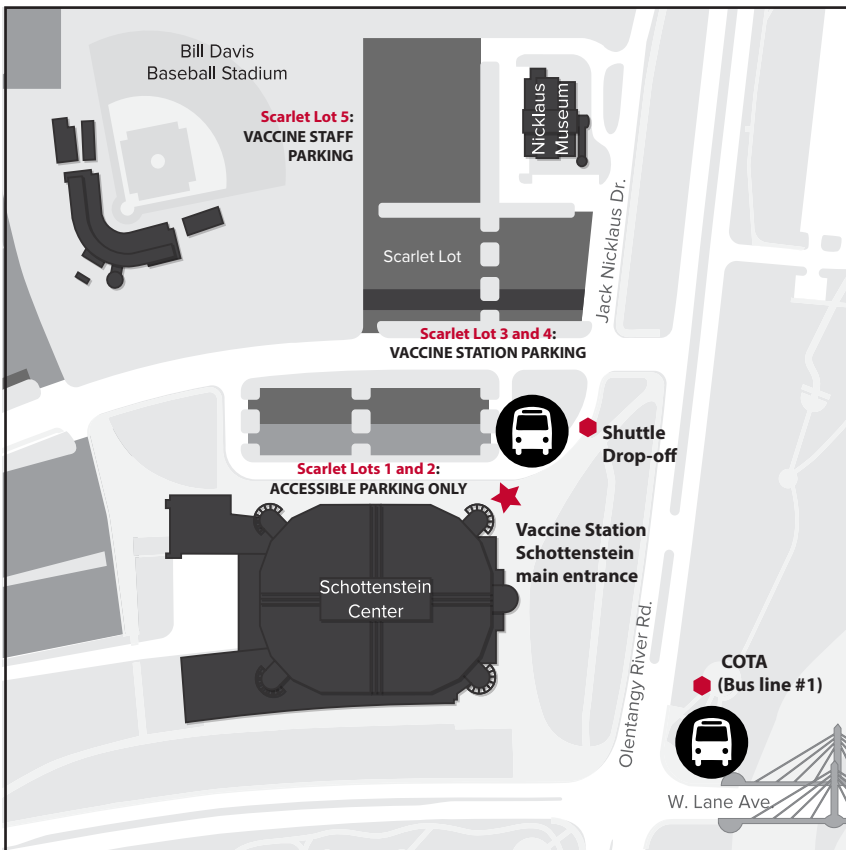


### Getting There

Take State Route 315 to the Lane Avenue exit  
Head east onto W Lane Avenue (*if coming from the North, turn left. If coming from the South, turn right*)  
Turn left onto Fred Taylor Drive  
Turn right onto Borror Drive

**Follow the signs for drop-off, accessible and general parking. Parking is free.**

*The Schottenstein Center is also served by COTA (Bus line #1) with a stop on the northeast corner of Lane Avenue and Olentangy River Road.*



### Additional Information

- Enter at the northeast side near the accessible parking. Wheelchairs are available onsite. A shuttle will provide assistance with transportation to the entrance if needed.
- If you require support, you may have one adult caregiver accompany you during your appointment.
- Vaccines are available by appointment only. You should allow for 45-60 minutes for your appointment.
- If you cannot make your scheduled time, please cancel via MyChart or by calling **614-688-VAXX (8299)**.
- Wear a mask and dress accordingly for access to your upper arm. Social distancing will be enforced.
