## FY20 Summary of Diversity and Inclusion Training Completions

In **FY20**, there were **26,263** completions in the **cultural competency curriculum**. Three main training modalities included 1) Online computer-based courses 2) Instructed-led interactive courses and 3) Self-selected which included attending conferences, grand rounds and volunteer options.

**Online computer-based courses** was the most popular option and accounted for 90.79% of completions. 67% of the completions were for the new and outstanding Implicit Bias training in collaboration with the Kirwan Institute. This is a big win because last year, Introduction to Cultural Sensitivity was the most popular option and this year we featured this course instead! The full list of options is below.

**Instructor-led interactive courses** accounted for 8.05% of completions. In comparison a smaller percentage overall but a significant amount of training occurred, especially considering that there were many end of year cancellations due to Covid-19.
