### The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center

As one of the largest academic medical centers in the country, we've always been on the leading edge of education, discovery and patient care — and now we're going even further.

The Ohio State Wexner Medical Center, part of one of the most comprehensive health sciences campuses in the country and the only academic medical center in central Ohio, is at the forefront of medicine. Here, discovery and innovation in our research laboratories translate to unique and effective therapies — available to patients well before they reach other hospitals.

These initiatives take place across our vast health care platform: within the Ohio State College of Medicine, at more than a dozen affiliated research centers and inside seven hospitals, where more than 60,000 inpatients receive medical care annually.

In addition, we have a unified physician practice, representing more than 2,000 preeminent physicians, and a network of community-based primary and subspecialty care facilities that manage more than 3.3 million patient visits each year.

We offer health care services in virtually every specialty and subspecialty in medicine.

### The Ohio State University Comprehensive Cancer Center – Arthur G. James Cancer Hospital and Richard J. Solove Research Institute (OSUCCC – James)

The OSUCCC – James strives to create a cancer-free world by integrating research with excellence in education and patient-centered care. Ohio State is a National Cancer Institute (NCI)-designated Comprehensive Cancer Center, a designation competitively maintained since 1976, and is one of only a few centers funded by the NCI to conduct phase I, II and III clinical trials on novel anticancer drugs provided by the NCI.

As the cancer program's 356-bed adult patient care component, The James is one of the nation's largest cancer hospitals and one of the best in the nation as ranked by *U.S. News & World Report*. With 21 floors and more than 1.1 million square feet, The James fosters collaboration and integration of cancer research and clinical cancer care.

To increase critically needed cancer research funding at the OSUCCC – James, Pelotonia was established in 2008 and has become the No. 2 cycling fundraiser in the country, raising more than \$309 million since its inception. Thanks to the event's major funding partners, every dollar raised by participants goes toward innovative cancer research and initiatives such as the Pelotonia Institute for Immuno-Oncology at the OSUCCC – James.

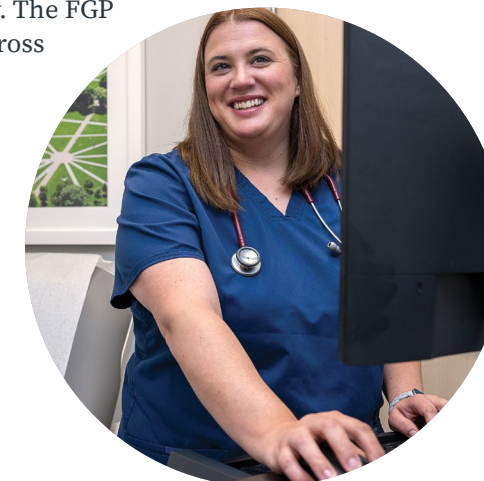


### Ohio State University Physicians, Inc./Faculty Group Practice

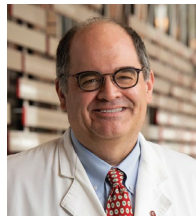

## Unparalleled discovery

Research is an integral part of what makes The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center such a force in the global medical community. Our investment in research and commitment to the investigative process have led to many breakthroughs and innovative discoveries. We encourage research at all levels, knowing that the research seeds planted today will yield life-changing results now and in the future.

The Ohio State University has one of the most comprehensive health science campuses in North America – with colleges of Medicine, Nursing, Pharmacy, Dentistry, Optometry, Public Health and Veterinary Medicine – adjacent to the tremendous resources and expertise of other university departments. With research centers dedicated to cancer, heart and lung disease, behavioral medicine and more, plus more than 140 shared core labs, we foster collaboration and shared resources that maximize grant dollars and time to discovery.

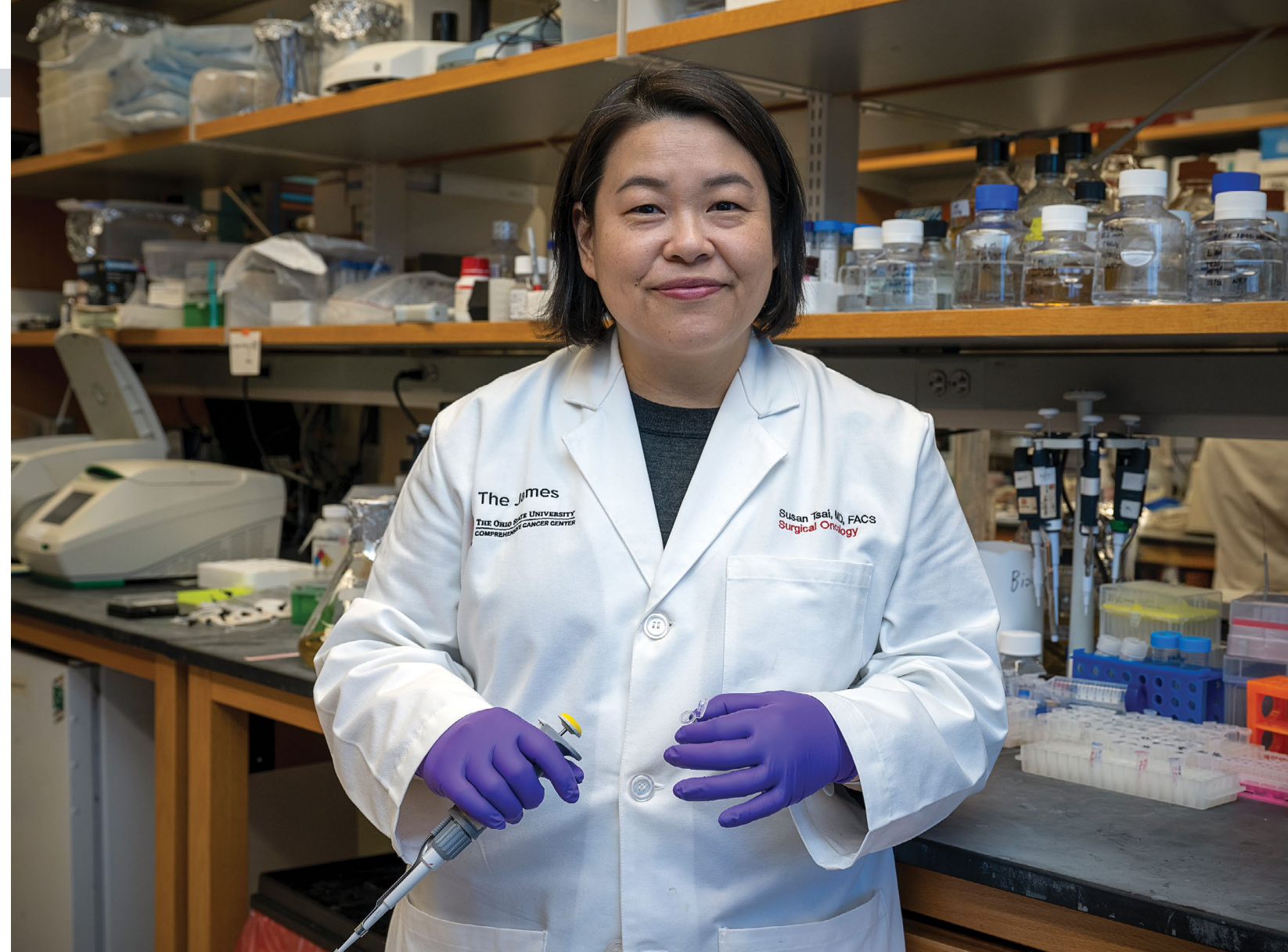
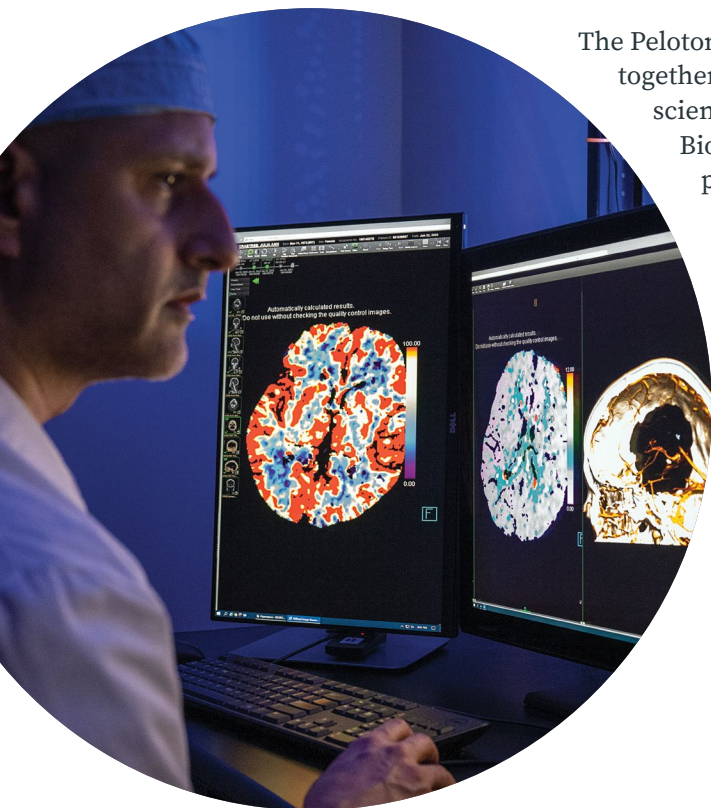
The Ohio State University Comprehensive Cancer Center – Arthur G. James Cancer Hospital and Richard J. Solove Research Institute (OSUCCC – James) contains five highly interactive and collaborative cancer research programs: Cancer Control, Leukemia and Hematologic Malignancies, Cancer Biology, Molecular Carcinogenesis and Chemoprevention, and Translational Therapeutics. About 300 scientists from 12 of the 15 colleges at The Ohio State University are funded members of one of these research programs. Member work includes basic laboratory studies, translational research and clinical trials. Altogether, Ohio State’s cancer program comprises some 1,700 researchers.

The Pelotonia Research Center is a state-of-the-art facility that brings together a multidisciplinary team of Ohio State researchers and scientists, from the College of Medicine to Biostatistics and Biomechanical Engineering. The center’s goal is to save more patient lives by shortening the time from initial research to new treatment options.

Among other initiatives, the center’s collaborative and interactive environment has led to the Pelotonia Institute for Immuno-Oncology, a bench-to-bedside research program focused on harnessing the body’s immune system to fight cancer at all levels, and the Center for Cancer Engineering – Curing Cancer Through Research in Engineering and Sciences (CCE-CURES) program, which designs, develops and integrates innovative engineering technologies and data analytics with cancer biology, biomechanics and fundamental science.

### College of Medicine

For more than 100 years, The Ohio State University College of Medicine has combined innovative medical education with leading-edge research and science-based patient care.

We're proud of what we've accomplished and of our impact on the changing face of medicine. Our leaders have charted a course for the future as we continually evolve to meet ever-changing demands in medicine.



The Ohio State College of Medicine is consistently ranked among the top medical schools in the United States, both public and private. The college's innovative curriculum places students in clinical settings from the start of their first year. We're one of the few schools in the world to offer five dual medical degrees: MD/PhD, MD/MBA, MD/JD, MD/MHA and MD/MPH. Our School of Health and Rehabilitation Sciences offers degrees in health information management and systems, health sciences, medical laboratory science, radiologic sciences and therapy, respiratory therapy, physical therapy, occupational therapy, dietetics and nutrition and athletic training.

More than 80 accredited graduate and residency programs train more than 1,023 residents and fellows each year. In addition, physicians and other health professionals in approximately 150 countries access our web-based continuing medical education programming each year.

## Supporting the health and wellness of our community

As a land-grant institution, we hold a special responsibility to take care of our Ohio communities.

### Traveling to our patients

Various mobile units bring health care directly into underserved communities and make it easier for individuals to get important screening and preventive care.

- The Ohio State Community Care Coach offers convenient, walk-in care from a broad team of health care professionals.
- The OSUCCC – James has two mobile units with the latest digital mammography technology.
- Our Mobile Education Kitchen travels across central Ohio to share healthy food and nutrition information.
- The James Mobile Lung Screening Unit makes it easier to get important pulmonary testing, especially for those living in rural and underserved communities.



### Combating infant mortality

Franklin County's infant mortality rate is one of the highest in the nation, with Black babies dying at twice the rate of white babies. It takes an entire community to save our infants, so we're committing substantial professional and volunteer support to the cause.



### A new model for health care

Located on Columbus' Near East side, the Healthy Community Center provides free health information and screening, along with special events and activities to help area residents create lifelong healthy habits. The center includes a teaching kitchen, community meeting spaces, healthy cafe, an outdoor garden, fitness rooms and more. All events and activities are offered free of charge.

## The new Ohio State University Hospital

**Our new 26-story University Hospital is the largest single facilities project ever undertaken at Ohio State.** It's designed to enhance a unified Ohio State Wexner Medical Center campus providing world-class patient care, leading-edge research and outstanding clinical training.

- **820 large, private rooms** (nearly doubling the number of previous beds), each equipped with advanced technology and safety monitoring blended with amenities designed to enhance comfort and create a healing environment.
- **An abundance of light throughout**, including 9-by-9-foot windows in every patient room
- **State-of-the-art diagnostic, treatment and inpatient service areas**, including 234 ICU beds, 51 neonatal ICU bassinets, 10 interventional radiology suites, six endoscopy rooms and four bronchoscopy rooms.
- **24 ORs** averaging 660 square feet (with two hybrid ORs topping 1,000 square feet)
- Other features to support well-being include a **more than half-acre terrace** with lush landscaping, a peaceful 3,250-square-foot **conservatory with natural light** and lounge seating and a **quiet sanctuary for all faiths**. The hospital also offers mobile ordering for **fast, convenient meals and 24/7 dining access** in a 400-seat dining area and two coffee shops.

### Built for you

Our new hospital was not only designed for patients and visitors, but also our own faculty, staff and learners. With their input, we've incorporated advanced technology to support workflows and improve how we work together and care for others.

**Easy navigation** – Our standardized floor plan ensures staff can quickly locate essential spaces on any floor.

**Well-being support** – Dedicated staff respite areas provide quiet spaces for reflection and rest.

**Relax and recharge** – Staff lounges feature an abundance of natural light and offer stunning city and stadium views.

**Privacy** – Single-use staff bathrooms and private staff changing spaces are located on every floor, along with private food lockers.

**Comfort** – Height-adjustable workstations enhance ergonomic comfort and staff safety.

**Enhanced connections** – The connectors between the new inpatient hospital and the OSUCCC – James allow for seamless patient care and collaboration.

**Working-parent support** – Sixteen lactation rooms are equipped with multiple stations, privacy curtains, breast pumps, sinks, microwaves, refrigerators and computers.

Across the university, we're paving our bold, innovative path forward by building the campus of the future to support teaching, learning, research and patient care. This extraordinary undertaking includes the expansion of our premier academic medical center.

**New University Hospital:** Our flagship facility with some of the region's most advanced technology and state-of-the-art inpatient care.

Additional diagnostic and treatment space will also be available at nearby **University Hospital – Pavilion**, **University Hospital – Rhodes Hall** and **University Hospital – Doan Hall**.

**Dodd Rehabilitation Hospital:** Home to our acclaimed inpatient program specializing in stroke, brain and spinal cord rehabilitation.

**East Hospital:** Blends the friendly atmosphere of a community hospital with all the advantages of a major medical center.

**Harding Hospital:** The most comprehensive psychiatric and behavioral health services in central Ohio.

**James Cancer Hospital and Solove Research Institute:** One of the largest cancer hospitals in the country and the only freestanding cancer hospital in central Ohio, with satellite clinics such as the Stefanie Spielman Comprehensive Breast Center and The James Outpatient Care, which has central Ohio's only proton therapy center.

**Richard M. Ross Heart Hospital:** The nation's first hospital dedicated to cardiovascular care.

### Our central Ohio facilities

Beyond our six hospitals, the Ohio State Wexner Medical Center has more than 100 facilities across central Ohio to provide convenient patient access and the space needed for the most technologically advanced research, teaching and patient care possible, including a network of primary care, outpatient and urgent care facilities, as well as dedicated specialty facilities for sports medicine, ENT and more.

## Collaborative medical and health science campus

The College of Medicine and the Interdisciplinary Health Sciences Center are housed in a newly renovated and expanded space totaling more than 220,000 square feet. Opened in 2024, this upgraded facility supports our focus on interdisciplinary curriculum across the seven health science colleges to better match the way health care professionals practice and face challenges in the real world.



### Pelotonia Research Center

This five-story research center, which opened in 2023, advances the university's strategic plan and framework with state-of-the-art laboratories serving multiple research disciplines, including biomedical, life sciences, engineering and environmental sciences. In addition, two floors are dedicated to the OSUCCC – James, including a second home for the OSUCCC – James Pelotonia Institute for Immuno-Oncology and a home for the OSUCCC – James Center for Cancer Engineering.

We've expanded the number of outpatient care facilities across central Ohio to bring our world-class care into the community. One location focuses on cancer care, while eight others simplify access to a broad range of medical specialties.
