Why Rehabilitation?

- Most MS symptoms can be addressed in rehabilitation
 - The goal is to keep functioning in important roles longer
 - Improvement OR Maintenance
- Resource across the lifespan
 - Individuals diagnosed with MS have a lifespan similar to their peers
 - This long lifespan allows increased time for potential disability
 - Older adults are at higher risk for other co-morbidities in addition to the MS
 - Early intervention, middle intervention and late intervention through rehabilitation services

Rehabilitation Settings

- Acute Care
 - Return patient safely home if possible
 - Recommend next level of care needed if home is not possible
- Inpatient Rehabilitation
 - Return patient safely to home environment
 - Recommend next level of care needed if home is not possible
- Home Health Rehabilitation
 - Improve home safety and access
 - Improve ability to access community safely to allow transition to OP care
 - Must be "homebound" according to CMS guidelines
- Outpatient Rehabilitation
 - Improve function, safety and overall mobility
 - Progress higher level goals for community access as able

OSU Outpatient Rehab Team

- Team based approach to MS Rehab
 - 15 multidisciplinary team members across disciplines PT, OT, SLP, SW
 - Comprehensive rehab program for MS shows best outcomes
- MS specific team within a larger team of experts
 - Neurologic Rehab
 - Orthopedic Rehab
 - Pelvic Floor Rehab
 - Vestibular Rehab
 - Alternative Mobility and Communication
 - Driver's Rehabilitation

 - PT/OT/SLP specializing in technology


