Out of pocket contingent upon your insurance coverage; national average estimated at \$1,500

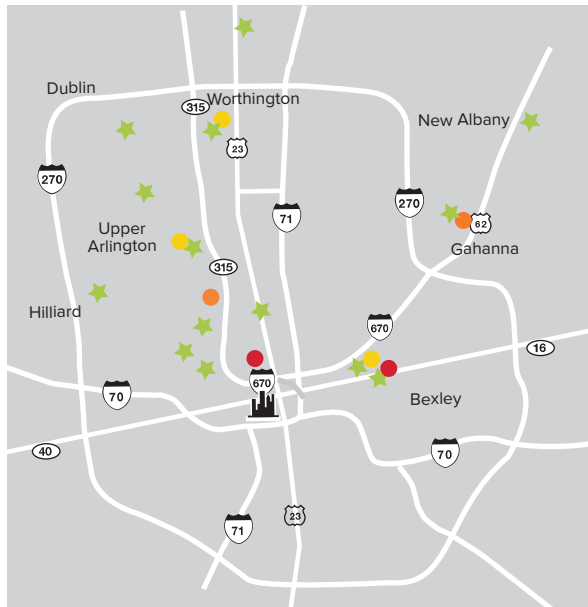
