



Keep access to Ohio State doctors with your 2024 plan selection

Thank you for choosing The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center and The Ohio State University Comprehensive Cancer Center – Arthur G. James Cancer Hospital and Richard J. Solove Research Institute (OSUCCC – James) for your health care. As a new open enrollment period draws near, we encourage you to review your plan and its providers. Open enrollment for selecting new plans runs from Nov. 1 to Jan. 15, and coverage will begin Jan. 1, 2024.

The following Marketplace/Exchange plans cover care at Ohio State:

- Buckeye Ambetter (excludes Physician Mental Health and Substance Abuse services)
- CareSource Marketplace
- Molina Healthcare of Ohio

There are a lot of factors to consider when choosing a health care plan. To help you make an informed decision, we've developed a checklist to use when you explore plan options (see back page). The checklist can help you choose a plan that's affordable, follows you where you travel and covers Ohio State doctors.

Ask the right questions. Choose the right plan.

- What is covered and what is not covered on this plan?
- What are my out-of-pocket expenses? Co-pays? Deductible? Co-insurance?
- What is my out-of-pocket maximum?
- Does the plan cover out-of-state or out-of-network expenses if I need care while traveling?
- If I spend winters or other periods of the year out of state, will this plan cover my doctor visits there?
- Can I continue to see my current primary care doctor and other specialists on this plan?
