Ask the right questions. Choose the right plan.

- What is covered and what is not covered on this plan?
- What are my out-of-pocket expenses? Co-pays? Deductible? Co-insurance?
- What is my out-of-pocket maximum?
- Does the plan cover out-of-state or out-of-network expenses if I need care while traveling?
- If I spend winters or other periods of the year out of state, will this plan cover my doctor visits there?

•	Can I continue to see my current primary care doctor and other specialists on this plan?

- Outside of emergencies, which hospitals are included and which ones are not?
- Does this plan cover care at the Ohio State Wexner Medical Center?

- Will I need supplemental policies to cover any other health or medical expenses?
