The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center Cardiac Resuscitation Internship

Requirements:

1. Ohio State University undergraduate student in good academic standing (2015 academic year) with a GPA ≥ 3.0 .
2. Demonstration of interest in cardiac resuscitation.
3. Able to commit a minimum of 10 hours per month for one year to the internship (not including monthly meetings).
4. Completion and submission of application.

Description:

Each year, greater than 400,000 people in the United States are victims of cardiac arrest. Unfortunately, the majority of these people will not survive. However, if these people receive cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) their survival can increase by two to three times.

The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center (OSUWMC) strongly believes in improving the survival from cardiac arrest in Ohio. With this goal, OSUWMC has formed the Cardiac Resuscitation Internship Program.

This program is a one-year undergraduate internship formed in conjunction with Columbus Division of Fire and the American Heart Association. The goal is to improve the provision of CPR in the community by providing community CPR training and organizing community programs to increase awareness.

The internship is a volunteer experience where they receive training in advanced CPR skills, public speaking, and community outreach along with potential career development opportunities of Emergency Department or EMS shadowing, curriculum vitae development and even potential research opportunities.
